Some of the most popular and recognized songs of all time were recorded by Artie Shaw and his band in the 1930's, 40's and 50's. Popular hits such as *Stardust*, *Begin the Beguine* and *Moonglow* are now staples of the American Songbook. Currently, the Artie Shaw Orchestra is one of the best of the big bands remaining from the glorious swing era and continues to tour the world, thrilling big band aficionados and swing dancers alike.

She has attracted the finest dancers from such mature companies as The Kirov Ballet, The Maly Ballet and The St. Petersburg Ballet Theatre of Askold Markov. Since winning the Gold Medal in the Amber Necklace International Ballet Competition in Kalingrad, they have embarked on several successful tours across Russia, the former Soviet states, Europe, Scandinavia and currently the United States.

Since its founding in 1983 by Michael Levine, Dallas Brass has become one of America's foremost musical ensembles.
